The MV "Northern Dream" is a 65 foot Sea Ranger motor yacht. It's home port is Astoria Oregon where it returns every year from S.E. Alaska. In Alaska, it offers our clients a variety of trips from day whale watching, overnight glacier & kayak tours to our 8 day 7 night "Discovery" cruise. While on the Columbia River, she offers people the chance to see the best parts of the river while enjoying various stops along the way. In our exclusive "Columbia River Wine Tasting Yacht Cruise" we take passengers to various vineyards and wineries along the way. In addition, we take them to museums, places of interest and allow them to visit the Pacific ocean, something other boat companies often do not have time for. Our passenger count per trip is low (only 3 couples) so they are sure to receive extra attention. Each stateroom has a queen sized bed, private well appointed bathroom, TV and DVD player with over 30 movies to chose from. The boat is spacious with full walk around decks and a front view seating area forward of the pilot house. The upper deck also has comfortable seating with a 360 deg. view. The boat is equipped with a launch boat and kayaks. Additional seating is available in the aft cockpit area as well. The windows are large which allows for great views while dinning or underway. The interior is finished with solid teak and mahogany for a warm and inviting atmosphere. The meals are first class as we have on staff a professional trained chef that prepares all the meals onboard our vessel.

The Northen Dream is owner operated by two licensed Captains with many years of experience on both the Columbia River and

in SE Alaska. All the crew are US citizens and speak English.

NOTE: Passengers <u>must</u> be able to climb steps as all staterooms are accessed by steps as is the entry and exit of the boat.

Columbia River Wine Tasting Yacht Cruise Daily Itinerary:

DAY ONE Passengers arrive at PDX airport. Hotel shuttle to local hotel for the day.

DAY TWO 10:00 am Passengers are picked up at Hotel and transported to the boat.



NOTE: The boat will be at one of two places: Hood River Oregon or Ilwaco WA. The route below will then transpire in reverse.


12:00pm Passengers arrive at boat and settle in with lunch. At around 2:00pm, guests are taken to *Cape Disappointment "Lewis & Clark Observatory"* Arrive back at boat: 4:30pm for cocktail hour and dinner. After dinner, downtown Long Beach and the *Long Beach Boardwalk*. Back to boat at guest's pace.

DAY THREE 8:30 am Breakfast: Underway to Astoria. 10:00am: En-route to the Astoria Maritime Museum. Return for lunch on boat. (time is determined by passengers) After lunch, guests are taken to the Astoria Column and then stop by the "Shallon Winery" makers of chocolate orange and cranberry wines. Exclusive tour not open to other boat companies. Afterward, guests are taken to Seaside Oregon and the "Buddah Kat Winery." Then to Cannon Beach to visit "The wine Shack" and view "Haystack Rock." Depending on the time and if the passengers agree, then we will visit The "Nehalem Bay Winery" Back to the boat for cocktail hour and dinner.

Columbia River Wine Tasting Yacht Cruise Daily Itinerary:

DAY FOUR 8:30am Breakfast underway. Cruise up river to Portland Oregon. Arrive downtown Portland up the Willamette River. Dock at Waterfront Park marina at or around 6:00pm. Dinner served. Guests free to walk downtown to visit Pioneer Square and water front park area. Guests return at their own time.

DAY FIVE 8:30am Breakfast. 9:30am guests are picked up for a *Willamette Valley* wine and vineyard tour. Northern Dream has chosen the "Sip 47 the road less traveled" (see map below) to visit various vineyards and wineries along hwy. 47 near Forest Grove.

NOTE: Lunch will be purchased by the passengers at local restaurant while on the tour. Dinner served at boat.

Dinner served on boat on or around 6:00pm depending on pace of our guests.

DAY SIX 8:30 am Breakfast: Underway to Hood River Oregon. Lunch served underway Transit through Bonneville Dam Lock. Arrive at Hood River dock at or around 6:00pm Dinner served. Passengers free to walk down town hood river. Guests return at their own pace.

Columbia River Wine Tasting Yacht Cruise Daily Itinerary:

DAY SEVEN 8:30am Breakfast. Guests picked up and taken up the "Fruit Loop" to visit various vineyards and wineries. This scenic route is famous for it's views fruit stands and vineyards.

The amount of places visited depend on the pace of the guests, time at each tasting and preference. Passengers are never rushed. Dinner at boat between 6:00pm and 7:00pm

DAY EIGHT 8:30am Breakfast. 9:30am Guests picked up and taken to Maryhill Museum of Art followed by a view of the Stonehenge Memorial. Next a stop at Maryhill Winery for a sample of the local Washington wine. Lunch in town, guest choice (time determined by length of winery visit) After lunch, guests are then transported to the local Western Antique Aeroplane & Automobile Musium. Dinner on boat.

Final day on board. 8:30am Breakfast 9:30 Guests transported to the **DAY NINE** Bonneville Dam Tour. On the way to Portland, we stop at the Mutnomah Falls on the way to PDX. Arrival at Portland Airport will depend on the schedules of our guests.
